Dairy Educational Display Guidelines

• A notebook must be completed the first year you are eligible for each age group (Junior, Intermediate, Senior).

Example: First year in Junior age group, you must complete a notebook. Second year and beyond in Junior age group, you can choose between completing a notebook or creating an educational display.

• You must bring your notebook to judging even if you are doing an educational exhibit with the following information updated:

Dairy

- Gallon of Milk Letter (personal handwritten letter)
- List of at least 3 people contacted for donations

Dairy Feeders

- Buyer Letter (personal handwritten letter)
- At least one buyer contacted
- Proof of vaccinations
- Thank you note per feeder
- BQA Certificate
 - Educational display may be on the following:
 - Poster of any dairy or dairy beef topic
 - **Display** of any dairy or dairy beef topic
 - Model of any dairy or dairy beef topic
 - Examples of topics include the following:
 - Parts
 - Breeds
 - Diseases
 - Feeding
 - Dehorning
 - Castrating
 - Cuts of meat
 - Milk

- Any other topic regarding dairy
