- EXHIBITOR'S AGE AS OF JANUARY 1, 2024
- **Michigan 4-H RULES APPLY.** This includes 4-H Cloverbud Horse and Pony Rules for youth ages 5 – 7 years. Cloverbud classes will be noncompetitive and will NOT be placed, instead they will each receive a participation award.
- Proof of Negative Coggins MUST be presented at entry office.
- Stall Cards must be displayed at stalls in use. Stall Cards are provided upon payment.
- **There can be NO shavings, manure or trash left in stalls or on the grounds.**
- Riders must wear discipline appropriate attire for their classes. Boots with a heel required in ALL classes. Half Chaps are acceptable.
- **ASTM/SEI RIDING HELMET REQUIRED IF YOU ARE AGE 18 AND UNDER.**
- Any class may be cancelled, split, combined or added at the discretion of the show committee.
- All patterns will be posted at the entry booth.
- All Trail classes will be held in separate arenas. Listen for announcements!
- Adult spotters are allowed in all W/T riding classes.
- Walk/Trot rider/equine combinations may not enter Walk/Trot/Canter classes!
- PEP classes - exhibitors may not enter divisions.
