According to the current federal Labor Standards
Act, youth employed over the age of 14, that have
not obtained their driver's license and plan to
operate a 20 PTO HP or greater garden or
agricultural tractor on property not owned, leased
or operated by a parent/legal guardian, are
required to have a tractor operator certificate.
