- **Sheep are raised in nearly every county in Michigan.**
- **“Lamb” is used to define sheep meat from an animal that is less than 1 year of age, “mutton” defines meat from sheep over 1 year of age. Lamb has a milder flavor than mutton.**
- **Lamb contains many vitamins, minerals and protein. Some favorite lamb products are leg of lamb, kabobs, lamb chops and rack of lamb.**
- **In addition to meat, sheep also produce the premiere natural fiber, wool, and some breeds are also known for their milk which is often made into cheese.**
- **Consumer products using sheep by-products include lanolin, instrument strings, rug pads, carpets, candles, ceramics, dish soap, dog food and many more.**
