Max credits to fulfill this requirement is not 17, but 15 (4+4+4+3)?</p> <p>#15 3g. For simplicity “Three credit of any approved study abroad”</p> <p>* Also, study abroad = Education Abroad</p> <p>Noted previously: The limitation statements in the concentrations are still confusing (ie “Courses used to fulfill this requirement cannot be used to fulfill requirements in 3f above”). Rephrase limitation statements to say “courses used to fulfill this requirement cannot be used to fulfill MAJOR requirements”?</p> <p>* Suggestion to BOLD the concentration titles so that they stand out.</p> <p>Noted previously: In several places there are statements like “A minimum of 9 credits (9-12 credits)”. The range is not needed – the credits are specified.
