- Application needs to include your official high school transcript and/or a copy of your-letter of college/trade school acceptance.

- \$2,500 Market or Non-Market Animal Exhibitor
- The scholarship will-be awarded during the 4-H awards ceremony at the Northwestern Michigan Fair

- The scholarship monies will be disbursed by the Michigan 4-H Foundation. Payment will be made to the institution, in which they attend for either their 1st or 2nd year.
- Scholarship money is to be used for tuition, room and board or fees.
