What is the WFPMIYI? The World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute is a one-day event that provides middle and high school students with the opportunity to share their ideas on how we can solve critical global challenges. More information is available @ https://www.canr.msu.edu/wfpmiyi/index

When and where: The World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute will be held Thursday, May 11, 2023, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Eastern Time Zone). Participants have the option of joining the World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute in person on the campus of MSU in East Lansing, MI or by participating virtually using <u>Zoom</u>. New this year is an optional Networking Breakfast scheduled from 7:30 – 8:45 a.m. This will be a chance to meet some of the experts, MSU Extension staff, and other students informally before the day officially begins at 9 a.m. If you would like to attend the Networking Breakfast, select this option when you register.

Who: Students who are in grades 7 through 12 during the 2022-2023 school year are eligible to register by submitting a three-to-five-page paper that is written using our <u>Michigan Youth Institute Global Challenge Guide</u>. Teachers and Adult Mentors are also welcome to attend the event along with their students.

Cost: There is no registration fee for students or teachers/mentors to participate in the Institute thanks to the generous support of the Michigan 4-H Foundation, the World Food Prize Foundation, the MSU College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, MSU International Studies and Programs, MSU Extension, Michigan 4-H, and Michigan FFA. Lunch is provided for those attending the program in-person on the campus of MSU.

Register today for Michigan 4-H Capitol Experience!

At Michigan 4-H Capitol Experience, teens learn how to change the world for the better through engagement in Michigan's state government and public policy process. The 4-H Capitol Experience program, scheduled for March 12-14, in Lansing, has been described by past participants as "amazing", "life-changing", and "an opportunity unlike any other".

The three-day event, open to high-school-aged youth, includes tours of the Michigan Capitol, interactions with state legislators, meetings

with state agency staff, lobbyists and state-level experts and learning how policy is made. During the program, youth work in small teams to draft legislation on agriculture, civil rights, education, energy, environment and natural resources, health or law enforcement and corrections.

The cost to register in 2023 is \$365, which includes meals, material fees and lodging at the Radisson Hotel in downtown Lansing. Please contact your local 4-H program coordinator to inquire about local funding opportunities. Scholarships may also be available through your local Farm Bureau office.

World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute registrations due March 15!

As millions across the globe deal with food insecurity, the World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute (WFP MIYI) offers young people an opportunity to be part of the solution. Held May 11 in East Lansing, or by participating from anywhere else using Zoom video/web conference technology, the event seeks to inspire and prepare the next generation of global leaders to end world hunger.

Attendees will have the opportunity to share their ideas related to global food security with experts and other Michigan youth while learning how university faculty and staff members, researchers and students are working to address world hunger.

To participate, youth should be in grades 7-12 and register by the March 15 deadline. As part of the registration process, youth are required to prepare a two- to five-page research paper about a developing country and one of 20 key factors that affect food security. At the event, youth present and discuss their papers with other attendees and research and industry experts. They also participate in interactive activities related to global food challenges and engage with area experts to discuss solutions to global hunger and poverty.

The top performing students at the WFP MIYI will be selected to attend the World Food Prize Global Youth Institute in Des Moines, Iowa, in October. For more information, visit <u>https://www.canr.msu.edu/wfpmiyi/</u>. Registrations and papers are due March 15.
