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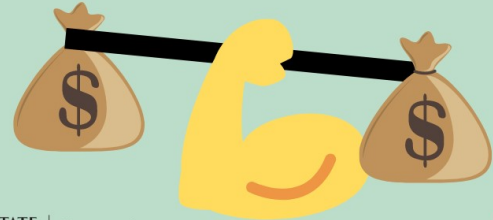

2. Be a graduate of the current year and be currently exhibiting in the livestock project area at the Ingham Co. Fair.
3. Plan to attend a college, university, or trade school upon completion of high school.
4. Expenses will be reimbursed up to \$500 when eligible receipt(s) are received.

NOTE: Up to 6 (six) scholarships will be awarded.

4-H members are eligible to win this scholarship *no more than one time*.
