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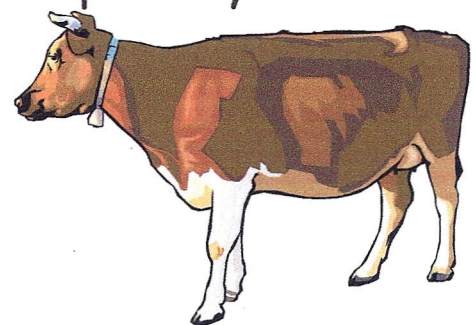
Objectives of the 4-H Cloverbud Beef Project

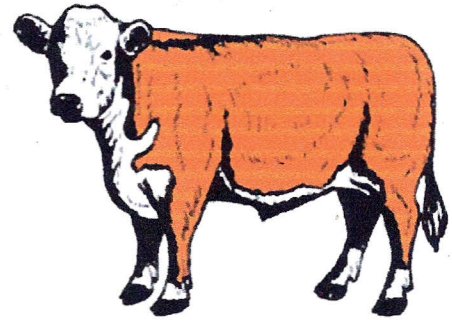
- ☺ Cloverbud projects are for the child to explore and discover project areas.
